Another of my goals is to ignite within students an appreciation for reading across genres and to use critical thinking skills when analyzing authors' literary work. During my student teaching at Madison South High School, I introduced classic literary allusions to students by challenging them to identify classical allusions in today's pop music. We used paired reading and literacy circles to delve into the writing of Mary Shelley and her classic novel, *Frankenstein*. Students explored how Shelley used personification, allusions, and tropes to tell a very human story that transcends generations to be pertinent in modern society. In conclusion of this unit, student groups analyzed themes found within science fiction pieces to create a final project.
